Students MUST have a valid permit to park on campus during the 2017-2018 school year.

Permit will be issued after review of the application and presentation by the student of:

1. a valid driver's license,
2. a student I.D.
3. proof of insurance, and
4. registration card for the family-owned vehicle(s) to which the permit will be used.
5. An unsealed envelope with your name and ID

All automobiles listed above MUST be owned by you or your family. This application must be completed and signed before a permit will be issued. Cash and checks (make payable to Prospect High school) are accepted. Registering another student's vehicle under your name will result in your permit being revoked. All eligible students who have been issued parking permits MUST hang it from their rear view mirror and be visible from outside the car.

Driving a vehicle on campus is a privilege that requires adherence to the rules listed below and in the STUDENT HANDBOOK.

1. I am currently a Sophomore, Junior or Senior as determined by District standards and the Deans at Prospect High School.
2. I am a licensed driver and am not driving on a ticket.
3. I agree to use only the tag I have purchased and understand that my tag is nontransferable and can only be used by me in my car.
4. I do NOT have any unserved detentions penalties from the 2016-2017 school year.
5. I agree to properly display my permit on my rear view mirror every day I am parked on campus.
6. I agree to drive only my registered car on the property of PHS and, furthermore, agree not to drive the vehicle of another student. I will not allow other students to operate my vehicle.
7. I understand that the administration of PHS can permanently or temporarily revoke my parking/driving privileges at any time.
8. I understand that if my parking privilege is revoked, I will not receive any monetary refund.
9. I understand that disciplinary consequences for misconduct, on or off campus, may include revocation of driving privileges.
10. I understand that my vehicle is subject to towing if I violate established rules, regulations or laws governing driving and parking.
11. I understand that the issuance of this parking permit does not assure a parking space.
12. Unoccupied cars must be kept locked at all times. School board policies and insurance do not cover damage or harm to private vehicles. The owner must assume all losses.
13. During the school day, students may only leave the campus in their cars during their scheduled lunch periods. Leaving campus in a car and cutting classes will result in revocation of parking permit.
14. Speeding, exhibition driving (spinning car around, sliding, spinning tires, etc.) or driving with a person on the outside of the car (on the hood, trunk, fender, etc.) will be reason for immediate and permanent revocation of driving privileges.
15. Students are permitted to park on school premises as a matter of privilege, not of right.
16. Police canines as well as Prospect's Safety Dog will be conducting random inspections of student parking lots. The interiors of student vehicles may be inspected whenever a school authority has reasonable suspicion to believe that illegal or unauthorized materials may be present. Such inspections may be conducted without notice, without student consent and without a search warrant.
17. If a student reaches a total of 4 hours of unserved detentions, their parking privileges will be revoked until detentions are resolved. There will be no refund of parking fees.
18. Students who have unserved detentions at the end 1st quarter, 2nd quarter, and 3rd quarter will have their permit suspended until detentions are served. a. 1st quarter ends October 13, 2017 b. 2nd quarter ends December 21, 2017 c. 3rd quarter ends March 16, 2018
19. Noncompliance with the aforementioned driving regulations can result in revocation of the driving permit/parking privilege.
20. Replacement permits can be purchased for \$10.00 in the Attendance office.
